Production Support Operator

MAJOR DUTIES:

- Perform all required work-area/equipment inspections in accordance with company policies and MSHA regulations.

- Use the wheel loader to grade active stockpile areas, crude shed, and traffic areas to maintain proper drainage and safe travel ways.
- Maintain clear communication and assist classifier operators as necessary.
- Able to assist in moving and wiring pit pumps.
- Assist with rotating weekend area inspection as required.
